PRINCIPLE study – Evaluating potential treatments for COVID-19 in older people	<p>Health and Care Research Wales is supporting the set-up of a Wales wide Urgent Public Health Platform study within primary care called the PRINCIPLE study run by Oxford University. The PRINCIPLE trial aims to find treatments for COVID-19 for older people. Public Health Wales Latest Advice	<p>PHW has advised that whilst non-essential shops in England are reopening, in Wales they will remain closed. English arrangements allowing a support bubble with another household, and the compulsory wearing of face coverings on public transport do not apply in Wales. Er mwyn mynd i'r afael â'r broblem hon mae'r Gwasanaeth Mabwysiadu Cenedlaethol ynghyd ag Iechyd Cyhoeddus Cymru wedi cynllunio proses ar ran asiantaethau mabwysiadu yng Nghymru sy'n galluogi i asesiadau meddygol barhau yn ystod yr argyfwng presennol.</p> <p>O 15 Mehefin 2020 ymlaen, bydd proses asesiadau meddygol rhithwir yn cael ei chyflwyno yng Nghymru ar gyfer mabwysiadwyr, i'w defnyddio pan na fydd modd cynnal archwiliad ac ymgynghoriad wyneb yn wyneb ag Ymgynghorydd Cyffredinol. To combat this problem the National Adoption Service alongside Public Health Wales have designed a process on behalf of the adoption agencies in Wales which enables medical assessments to continue during the current crisis.</p> <p>From 15th June 2020 a virtual medical assessment process will be introduced in Wales for prospective adopters which can be used where face to face examination and consultation by a GP cannot take place. This process is time limited and will be in place during the crisis whilst face to face examinations continue to be difficult to access. This temporary solution will enable prospective adopters to move on to adoption panel and approval decision, thus allowing the adoption process to progress and children to continue to be placed with their permanent families.</p>	<p> Eng Final Protocol for obtaining medical reports</p>
