Reimbursement payments are processed in six-month instalments in arrears. - Eligible applicants can now apply online and find out more about the scheme. Telephone help is available if you have difficulty in applying. We have recently met with representatives to discuss how we can keep the foster care system flowing whilst maintaining our focus on safeguarding children, minimising disruption to the fostering process and maintaining sufficiency of foster care placements.
