The document has been reframed from previous versions to reflect that a Trade and Cooperation Agreement (TCA) has now been agreed between the UK and EU, and that the new relationship has taken effect from 1 January 2021. The FAQs will continue to be updated regularly as further detail about implementing different aspects of the TCA becomes available.
